There'll also be time for discussion about the Christian faith and it's relevance to you today.

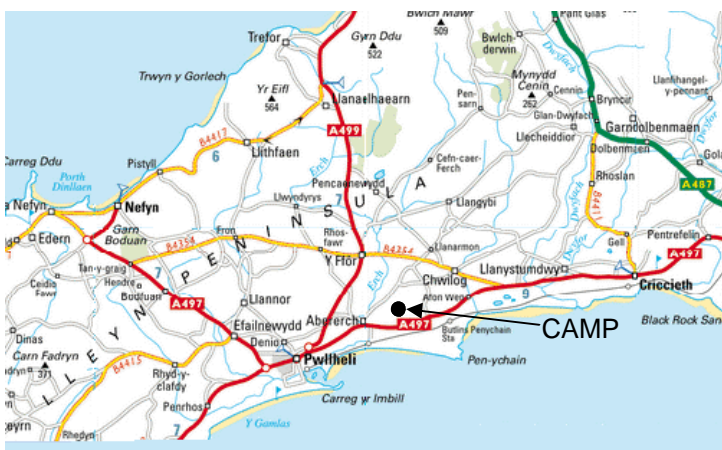


PARENTS & GUARDIANS

General Information

The cost of a week at camp is £155. This includes your travel from one of the pick up points, all meals, a number of outings, accommodation in tents for lads and chalets for girls.

There may be optional excursions and activities such as sailing, mountain boarding, horse riding etc., at an extra cost. You will be told about these prior to camp.

Applications, together with a non-refundable deposit of £45, should be made to your church camp rep. by 7th February with the remainder of the fee payable by 28th March.

Applications for all weeks of camp will close 2 weeks before the start of the week.

Please note that due to redevelopment it may be necessary to accommodate some girls in tents on the girls field

- All visitors must report to the Director as soon as they arrive.
- Parents are encouraged not to visit camp due to potential homesickness problems with campers.

Campers Agreement

1. Each day at camp there will be some time spent looking at the Bible and in praise and worship. You will be expected to attend and respect this time and not to disturb other people.
2. No aggressive or offensive behaviour or language will be tolerated.
3. You will be expected to behave with respect at all times; both to each other and to leaders. The Director and the Admin Team have the overall responsibility of ensuring MCYC runs smoothly and that everyone is able to enjoy themselves. If they feel your behaviour threatens this, you may be sent home.
4. Alcohol, illegal drugs, offensive weapons and tobacco are not permitted at Camp.
5. If you choose to bring a mobile phone and use it inappropriately or at inappropriate times it may be confiscated and returned to you at the end of the week.
